Some of these children are diagnosed with various disabilities ranging from Down Syndrome, Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Global Delay, Muscular Dystrophy, Dwarfism, Apeth Syndrome, Neunan Syndrome and Hyperactivity, among others. Besides that, the centre is also home to normal children from broken and abused families.



During the visit, Jadi's volunteers entertained the children with fun games, live musical performance and spectacular magic show. Visiting these children to see them smile and laugh makes this visit even more worthwhile than making mere financial contributions. Besides spending time at the centre to accompany the children, Jadi provided some stationery materials to the children and offered to recycle the centre's laser cartridges to help it save cost on printing supplies.
